



WHEAT INITIATIVE TRAVEL GRANT

A limited number of travel grants to attend the training course and the meeting of the Expert Working Group (EWG) on Durum Wheat Genomics (17.00-19.30 on 18 September at the Cosmopolitan hotel) will be available through the Wheat Initiative. Only members of the (i) EWG on Durum Wheat Genomics and Breeding, (ii) EWG on Wheat Phenotyping and (iii) EWG on Abiotic stresses are eligible for the travel grant. Each travel grant can be used to cover the cost of up to three nights (September 16, 17, 18) and travel expenses (e.g. flight tickets; only economy, public transport, etc.). The maximum contribution will be related to the distance of travel as follows:

- Participants from Italy: up to 200 €
- Participants from countries of WANA region and Europe except Italy: up to 600 €
- Participants from Asian and African countries other than the WANA region: up to 800 €
- Participants from USA, Canada, Central and South American countries: up to 1,000 €
- Participants from Oceania countries: up to 1,200 €.

RECIPIENTS WILL BE SELECTED BASED ON THEIR SUBMITTED APPLICATIONS.

Applicants must actively participate in the workshop. Applications will be evaluated by the organizing committee and results will be announced by 5 July.

Submission deadline for travel grant requests: 15 June.

Profile and conditions

You are affiliated to a university or a research institution and you are an early career scientist, PhD student, or postdoc who finished the PhD after 1 January 2013.

The application includes:

- Short CV (max. 1 page)
- Short motivation letter (max. half page)
- Travel cost estimate
