



WHEAT INITIATIVE TRAVEL GRANT

A limited number of travel grants to attend the workshop will be available through the Wheat Initiative. Each travel grant can be used to cover the cost of up to three nights and travel expenses (e.g. flight tickets - only economy, public transport, etc.). The maximum contribution will be related to the distance of travel as follows:

- Participants from France: up to 200 €
- Participants from countries of WANA region and Europe except France: up to 600 €
- Participants from Asian and African countries other than the WANA region: up to 800 €
- Participants from USA, Canada, Central and South American countries: up to 1,000 €
- Participants from Oceania countries: up to 1,200 €.

RECIPIENTS WILL BE SELECTED BASED ON THEIR SUBMITTED APPLICATIONS.

Applicants must actively participate in the workshop. Applications will be evaluated by the organizing committee and results will be announced by 15 August 2018.

Submission deadline for travel grant requests: 18 July 2018.

Profile and conditions

You are affiliated to a university or a research institution and you are an early career scientist, PhD student, or postdoc who finished the PhD after 1 January 2013.

The application includes:

- Short CV (max. 1 page)
- Short motivation letter (max. half page)
- Travel cost estimate
