The Wheat Initiative Strategic Research Agenda (SRA) was launched at the fourth Meeting of the G20 Agricultural Chief Scientists (MACS) on July 27, 2015 in Izmir (Turkey).

The Strategic Research Agenda contributes towards the global food security challenge by identifying priorities, game-changers and underlying priorities that will allow the efficient delivery of improved wheat varieties. The SRA builds on the [Wheat Initiative Vision Document](#) [1] launched in May 2013 and identifies policy-relevant key research challenges and priorities for the short, medium, and long term.
